Why Attend?

The REACH (**R**egistration, **E**valuation, **A**uthorisation and restriction of **CH**emicals), regulation came into force on 1 June 2007 and it is set to fundamentally change the shape of every manufacturing supply chain within the EU. REACH affects all chemical substances (including metals) that you manufacture, import or use to make your products and to run your processes. And with the first major deadline fast approaching, time is of the essence to get ready for REACH!

REACHReady are running this workshop to help companies with the practical implementation of the regulation. The comprehensive programme includes talks from a range of experts covering the implications for manufacturers, importers and users of chemicals throughout the supply chain.
