### REACH – the Basics

#### Who should attend?

Business and regulatory managers and specialists working in companies that make, import or use chemicals (essentially every manufacturing or construction business within or supplying to the EU) who are starting to define their obligations for REACH.

It would also be a useful introduction for anyone that professionally uses a product containing chemicals.

#### Why attend?

The REACH (Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and restriction of CHemicals), regulation came into force on 1 June 2007 and it is fundamentally changing the shape of every supply chain within the EU. REACH affects all chemical substances that you manufacture, import or use to make your products and to run your processes. With the first registration deadline of 2010, the real work has just begun.

This workshop is designed to help companies with the practical implementation of the regulation. The comprehensive programme provides an introduction to the key elements of the regulation and includes talks from a range of experts covering the implications for manufacturers, importers and users of chemicals throughout the supply chain.

In the afternoon the focus is on what are defined as 'Articles' under REACH – which means pretty much anything that isn't a chemical: clothing, furniture, construction products, motor vehicle parts etc. Every product is made from substances, and if the product contains a **Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC)** on the "**Candidate List**" then you may already have a duty to tell your customers about it and will want to ensure your suppliers tell of the presence of a SVHC in good time.
