Why Attend?

The talking's over – it's time for the real work to begin!

Pre-registration is due to begin on 1 June this year and it's vital that you know what to do and what not to do. **Come to this workshop to get all the answers.**

The REACH IT system will be open for those who import, manufacture or represent non-EU exporters of chemical substances to start the process. You have up until 30 November to pre-register but those who get in early are going to have the greatest opportunity to get the most out of the process, as discussions can begin right away.

In this workshop the **REACHReady** experts will bring you the very latest on how to gather the information you need to pre-register and how to submit your pre-registration to the European Chemical Agency (ECHA) using the REACH IT system. The workshop will also prepare you for the next stage of REACH when you'll find yourself in a pre-SIEF (substance information exchange forum) and provide you with some tips on how to make sure you end up in the right SIEF for you. (and don't worry - we'll explain what all of this means on the day!).

Who Should Attend?

This workshop will be of considerable value to business and regulatory managers who are, or who will be, undertaking the REACH compliance activities for their company.

This event is aimed at manufacturers and importers of substances in the EU or those who have been appointed as an only representative by a non-EU manufacturer.

Downstream users may also be interested in attending to understand the process (but note - downstream users do not have to pre-register).
